

- Rental rates have increased23% over the past five years
- Average rental rate is \$1.90/SF
- Average occupancy has increased and is 97.6%
- Newer projects commanding higher rents at \$2.25/SF
- New development could achieve average rental rate of approximately \$2.39/SF
- 471 apartment units permitted in 2020




